- 1 A sewing test on an industrial machine is required. This program requires extensive sewing and drafting. Students who enter the program with intermediate experience in working with commercial patterns and construction of garments have a better chance to succeed with program demands. Both sewing ability and access to a sewing machine outside of the campus facilities are expected.
- 2 Other arrangements will be made for applicants unable to attend information sessions.
- 3 Diploma/degree in business or fashion with a minimum GPA of 2.7 OR Diploma/degree with three years of directly related career experience Preference will be given to applicants who have some academic background in economics, marketing and logistics.
- 4 Applicants with international transcripts where TOEFL is not supplied must test at GBC College level English to be accepted.
