

How to Review Courses for Program Completion

A student can determine whether his/her program course requirements have been met by accessing Stu-View to review the courses successfully completed from Semester I through to Semester III. The student needs both student ID and PIN number to access Stu-View. Determining completed courses and their accompanying grades can also be done by the student reviewing his/her official transcripts sent through the mail at the end of each term.

The Practical Nursing Program's Student Handbook (page 48) identifies all program courses by semester that the student can use as a reference for determining the requirements.

If a student did semester I at Yorkdale Adult Learning Centre or Central Adult Learning Centre, he /she would have completed his/her semester I courses in order to have been accepted into semester II at GBC.
