1 What You Need:

- Ontario Secondary School Diploma with six Grade 12 University (U) or University/College (M) courses **including:** Grade 12 (U) English and any Grade 12 (U) Mathematics.
 - A grade of at least 60 in all prerequisite courses **and** an overall average of 65% in six Grade 12 (U) or (M) courses.
 - Recommended courses: basic computer software applications and Mathematics of Data Management (MDM4U).
- OR**
- Mature Student status (19 years of age or older): Grade 12 (U) English **and** Mathematics (or equivalent) are required; minimum grade of 65 in all required courses.
 - Post-secondary courses in English and Mathematics with a grade level of B or higher will be considered.

A TOEFL score of 580 (or equivalent), where applicable (see page 253).

Note: There is no assessment testing for this program. If the number of qualified applicants exceeds the number of seats available for this program, final student selection will be based on overall academic standing and/or grades in the required courses.
