



# Dual Credit Bursary Award Program Criteria 2018-2019

In 2011 George Brown College (GBC) developed a Dual Credit (DC) Bursary Award to recognize academic excellence and provide financial assistance to qualified former DC students enrolled in a full time program at GBC. We are pleased to offer Awards of **up to** \$1,000.

## Requirements:

- Students must have completed a GBC Dual Credit course with a grade of 80% or higher
- Students must be enrolled in a full-time post-secondary or apprenticeship program at GBC
- The program of study that the student has registered in at GBC does not have to correspond with the Dual Credit course that he/she completed in High School
- Students must demonstrate financial need
- Students are only eligible to receive a onetime bursary.

## Application Process:

- Students must complete a profile through the Student Awards tab on [STU-VIEW](#). \*As long as the above criteria is met, the application will be considered. Note: other awards and bursaries in addition to this bursary can be accessed through this application.
- Applications will be reviewed by the SCWI Coordinator. Successful recipients will be contacted by the SCWI Coordinator.
- Due to the competitive nature of the bursary, application does not guarantee an award.

The 2018-2019 bursary deadlines are as follows:

- Application deadline for **Fall semester** bursary: **September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018.**
- Application deadline for **Winter semester** bursary: **January, 31<sup>st</sup>, 2019.**
