General Education and Liberal Studies electives in the SPRING/SUMMER 2022 semester will be delivered online, either **asynchronously**, or with some **synchronous** sessions.

Asynchronous learning does <u>not</u> occur in the same place or at the same time. Teachers and students do not need to be available at any particular time or day. Resources will be available on Blackboard, usually with instructions to complete weekly modules.

Synchronous online learning occurs at the same time. The teacher and students will meet online, on Blackboard Collaborate, and will interact with each other in real time. Students should plan to be available at the scheduled class times. Although classes are scheduled for three hours, the Collaborate sessions will likely take up only some of that time. Students will also need to do work independently.

Hybrid learning combines asynchronous sessions and synchronous sessions. Teachers will provide more instructions for each course.
