


Students in the School of **Fashion and Jewellery** can travel to Peru and into the Andean Mountains for 10 days to participate in a **George Brown College** faculty-led abroad opportunity. In collaboration with the **Chio Lecca Fashion School**, students will meet with and learn from local master artisans, get first-hand experience in a sustainable industry, and learn processes that could influence future collaboration that could assist local Andean communities. Students will receive a program elective course credit after successfully completing this opportunity as well as a certificate of completion from **Chio Lecca**.



## **ELIGIBILITY**

To be eligible to participate, students must:

- Be enrolled full-time at George Brown College in the School Fashion and Jewellery.
- Have a minimum program GPA of 2.5.
- Require a program elective.
- Passport with at least 6 months validity after trip's end date.
- Meet all entry, exit and re-entry requirements for Peru and Canada (this information is subject to change at any time).



- Travel/medical insurance
- Vaccinations
- Some meals (not included in the final itinerary)
- Gratuities, souvenirs, personal purchases

## **FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES:**

Funding for this opportunity is available to eligible students through the Global Mobility bursary of up to \$1500 to all students (domestic and international), and Global Skills Opportunity (GSO) project, which is funded by the Government of Canada's Outbound Student Mobility Pilot Program. GSO project funding (of up to \$1500) is open to all domestic students, but will prioritize Indigenous students, low-income students, and those with disabilities. • Complete application and submit \$500 non-refundable deposit to the School of Fashion and Jewellery's main office (CL C430) by the deadline.
