



## Dual Credit Bursary Award Program Criteria Winter 2026

In 2011 George Brown Polytechnic developed a Dual Credit (DC) Bursary Award to recognize academic excellence and provide financial assistance to qualified former DC students enrolled in a full-time program at George Brown. We are pleased to offer Awards of up to \$500.

### Requirements:

- Students must have completed a George Brown Polytechnic Dual Credit course with a grade of 80% or higher.
- Students must be enrolled in a full-time post-secondary or apprenticeship program at George Brown Polytechnic.
- The program of study that the student has registered in at George Brown Polytechnic does not have to correspond with the Dual Credit course that he/she completed in high school.
- Students must demonstrate financial need.
- Students are only eligible to receive a onetime bursary.

### Application Process:

- Students must complete a profile through the Student Awards tab on [STU-VIEW](#). \*As long as the above criteria is met, the application will be considered. Note: other awards and bursaries in addition to this bursary can be accessed through this application.
- Applications will be reviewed by the Dual Credit Coordinator. Successful recipients will be contacted by the Dual Credit Coordinator.
- Due to the competitive nature of the bursary, application does not guarantee an award.
