Please note that transcript requests can take several weeks to process. Transcripts will then be directly mailed to you or if requested, you can access an online version.

If you decide to attend an Ontario college as a full-time student, in order to potentially receive a course exemption in a full-time program for your dual credit course, you will need the following information:

- 1) Your George Brown College transcript
- 2) The course outline for the dual credit course(s) that you completed (copies are available online under Course Outlines) or email <u>dualcreditprogram@georgebrown.ca</u> to request a course outline.
- 3) Your George Brown College student number (beginning with 101...)

For students who are now enrolled in full-time programs at George Brown College, you can complete the Application for Course Exemption Form available at: <u>Current Students Transcripts</u> Once this form has been completed, submit it to the Registrar's Office at George Brown College. Course exemption(s) help students transition to college by reducing course workload for those enrolled in full-time programs at George Brown College; however, it does not lower tuition cost.
