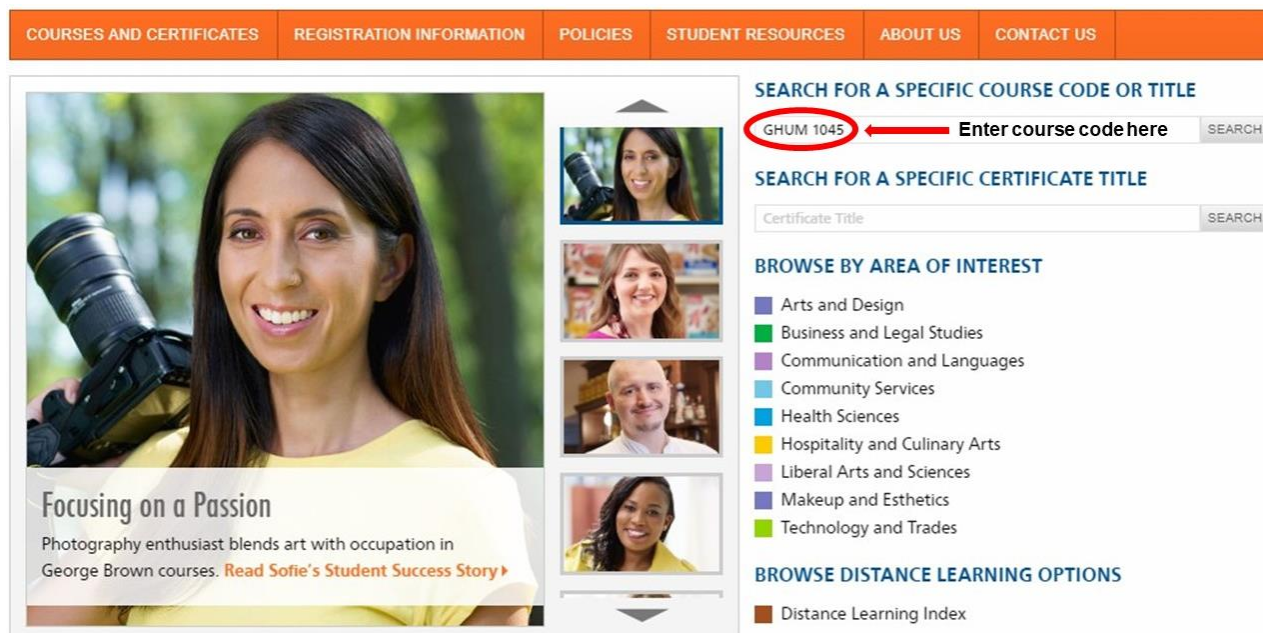
**The courses listed below do NOT apply as credit towards degree program requirements (i.e., they are not equivalent to Liberal Studies electives).**
