1.0 Purpose

This policy establishes guidelines, procedures, and responsibilities for all authorized users of George Brown Polytechnic Library Learning Commons (LLC) and demonstrates the LLC’s commitment to equitable, sustainable, inclusive, and safe environments for all members of the Polytechnic community.

2.0 Scope

This policy applies to all George Brown Polytechnic personnel as well as alumni and visitors on campus using Polytechnic technology and resources.

3.0 Definitions

4.0 Policy

4.1 Library Learning Commons Responsibilities

- 4.1.1 George Brown Polytechnic LLC supports the teaching and learning needs of the Polytechnic by providing equitable and sustainable student-centered access to materials, services, and spaces that facilitate student success
- 4.1.2 Equity, diversity, inclusion, and Indigenization guide the provision of all collections, services, and spaces.
- 4.1.3 The primary use of all material, services, and spaces is academic, and the LLC reserves the right to prioritize use for that purpose.

4.2 User Roles and Responsibilities

- 4.2.1 All authorized users are required to follow appropriate academic and Polytechnic policies (see related policies section) while using LLC spaces or LLC resources.
- 4.2.2 All George Brown Polytechnic authorized users (see definitions) may borrow and access LLC materials and spaces using their George Brown Polytechnic Photo ID.
- 4.2.3 Authorized users are responsible for all material borrowed in their name and are subject to applicable fines for overdue or replacement costs for lost and damaged material as outlined here georgebrown.ca/library-learning-commons/my-account/fines

- 4.2.4 Library borrowing privileges may be suspended when outstanding fines exceed \$10.00, or materials have not been returned within 30 days after the due date. Transcripts and credentials may be withheld by the Polytechnic until the student account is cleared.
- 4.2.5 LLC users have the right to consult and borrow resources without facing bias or prejudice. Information about the activities of individual borrowers – including materials used – is not released to any person, institution, or agency, except as may be required in the application of Code of Conduct, as required in matters of law enforcement, or under the provisions of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act [F.I.P.P.A.]
- 4.2.6 The LLC reserves the right to make changes to user privileges or fine structure with thirty days' notice.

4.3 Use of Spaces

- 4.3.1 LLC locations are learning environments that strive to accommodate diverse needs of their users. All authorized users should respect the rights of others and minimize impact on others when using the LLC spaces in accordance with the LLC's Respectful Use Guidelines.
- 4.3.2 The LLCs have established designated noise level guidelines that outline what level of noise is appropriate in silent, quiet, and collaborative zones.
- 4.3.3 The LLC reserves the right to protect LLC collections, space, furniture, and facilities and reserves the right to regulate the consumption of food and beverages in all spaces as outlined here:

- 4.3.4 All authorized users may access LLC spaces; however, certain spaces are reserved for registered students including group study rooms, individual study areas, and teaching labs. The LLC reserves the right to make changes to use of space needed to meet changing student demands. The use of Individual study and group study rooms are outlined here:

4.4 Use of Technology

- 4.4.1 All LLC authorized users are required to follow the Acceptable Use (of Technology) Policy when borrowing technology from, or using technology in, the LLC.

4.4.2 Users are required to complete a Technology Equipment Loan Agreement when borrowing technology from the LLC for the first time llc.georgebrown.ca/av/

5.0 Compliance

This policy requires compliance from all Polytechnic Personnel and other authorized users of the LLC. Failure to comply with this policy may result in disciplinary measures in accordance with the relevant and applicable Polytechnic academic and administrative codes of conduct and collective bargaining agreements.
