

Welcome New First year S100 Dental Technology students!

- In preparation for your dental practice both in-person and off-site, there are mandatory requirements that you will need to complete ahead of time. The Clinical Placement Office recommends that you begin gathering the necessary documentation now, in order to be able to submit it and provide enough time for the approval process.
- Once you have gathered all the necessary documents, please hold on to your certification for now and we will provide you with further information and instructions on how you can submit to us **by the given deadline on September 11, 2026**.
- If you **fail** to complete these requirements by the **given deadline on September 11, 2026**, you will be **excluded** from dental practice in the clinic and lab which can jeopardize your academic standing in the program.
- Please **note** that even if you have graduated from another Health Sciences program either in George Brown College or from another college, university or institution **and/or** have experience working in any health-related profession, you are still required to complete all the non-medical certificates below. If you **fail** to do so, you will be **excluded** from clinical field practice which can jeopardize your academic standing & may lead to program **withdrawal**.
- All costs, service fees and fines associated with the overall requirements are the responsibility of the student.

Below is a summary of all requirements that must be provided in your submission. Please read and follow all the instructions carefully:

Standard First Aid Certificate (must be valid for three years from September 2026 to April 2027)

CPR level C Certificate (must be valid each year from September 2026 to April 2027)

- All students must have a current [Standard First Aid \(must be valid every three years\)](#) and [CPR level C \(must be valid every year\)](#), to participate in dental practicum.
- Please **do not** register for an Emergency First Aid course or to any company that offers these courses 100% fully online, we will **not** accept these types of certificates. We would advise you to retake this course with another company that offers it either hybrid or in person and you will have to pay again. All costs and service fees are the responsibility of the student.
- If you live in Toronto region, please check the [criticalcaresimstitute.ca](#) and [Peak Excellence Shop](#) and scroll down to their Certificate packages for both WHMIS, SFA and CPR Level C certificates, as they have a student discount rates

Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System (WHMIS) certificate (must be valid each three years)

- The WHMIS online training course will provide you with a wealth of knowledge and skills to protect yourself and others while working with or around hazardous materials, the health effects of hazardous materials, WHMIS rights and responsibilities, hazards classification, symbols and WHMIS 2015 Pictograms and Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS).
- These will ensure that you receive the proper training prior to being exposed to any hazards that could potentially result in you becoming injured or ill within the school or workplace or surroundings.
- You may register for WHMIS Healthcare online training either at [Critical Care Sim Institute website](#) or [Peak Excellence Shop](#) and register for this course or at any organization or at your workplace.

Once you have everything done and completed, your final step is to create an account, submit and upload your completed health form documents to the at [ParaMed Placement Pass website](#) by the given deadline. If you **fail** to do so, you will be **excluded** from dental practice which can jeopardize your academic standing & may lead to program **withdrawal**.

(Service fees effective on September 1, 2025)

- Initial Clearance Fee-\$73.45 dollars tax included (unlimited document uploads until you received your first clearance, student will pay, and it is non-refundable)
- Subsequent Clearance Fee-\$36.73 dollars tax included (due to medical deficiency or incomplete requirements)
