George Brown was ranked as the

#1 research college in the country

for 2015, climbing from the #3 spot in 2014.1

1,782 student researchers conducted 181 applied research projects

during the 2015/16 academic year, giving them hands-on experience solving real-world business problems.²

To date, George Brown has received more than \$57 million

in research funding from provincial and federal programs, which has been matched by industry investments.³




